January 18-22, 2016

HS2 Exodus, Judges and Kings and Indigenous Histories

We journey with the families telling the story of Israel's formation as a people and their covenant with God. Through the covenant relationship the nation formed owes its allegiance to God. As the nation becomes unified – the stories of leadership emerge that cover a 400-year history described in the book of Judges. The stories in Judges are not of one leader but many local and overlapping tenures of unique people who emerged for specific times or events. The last prophet and judge, Samuel, who legitimizes the establishment of monarchs: first Saul and then David. The story of these kings and their successors is described in Kings. We will explore how land and community shapes our understanding of Creator. Indigenous stories and histories chronicle a life based on a relationship with Creator/God and creation – finding liberty from colonial oppression. History tells a story of transformation that we can learn from in this era of colonization.
