

SAND-SAULTEAUX SPIRITUAL CENTRE RENTAL GUIDELINES

Updated April 9, 2022

As Sandy-Saulteaux Spiritual Center re-opens to the public the health and safety of our guests, staff and community have guided the changes we have made to our operating procedures. Effective immediately, our new rental requirements include the following which are the **responsibility of the group organizer**:

- Certificate of Insurance for the rental period.
- Mask use is strongly recommended in indoor public places where physical distancing is not possible
- Hand sanitizing stations have been installed at each entrance door, and outside of each washroom and frequent use is encouraged.
- It is the responsibility of any guest to immediately notify their group leader plus a supervising staff person if they become ill. Covid guidelines are in place to deal with such an occurrence.
- Covid Rapid Tests and masks are available if required.
- The sweat lodge will remain closed at this time. Availability is reviewed monthly.

Our staff have completed courses from the Manitoba Tourism Education Council that highlight enhanced cleaning and disinfecting procedures that have come about as a result of Covid 19. We have updated our Standard Operating Procedures to match provincial and industry recommendations. You may notice a few differences in how things are done today. Be assured that these changes have come about to ensure that Sandy Saulteaux Spiritual Center welcomes guests to a clean and safe environment that in many instances may exceed Provincial guidelines and regulations. Further changes to our Covid Policies will be reviewed as necessary

We recognize that uncertainty and change is often difficult. This is new for all of us! Some of our most noticeable changes are:

1. You will be greeted by our Hospitality Co-Ordinator upon arrival.
2. Cabin rooms will be assigned to each guest. Any unoccupied cabin rooms will be closed.
3. Meals and beverages will be served buffet style to guests in the dining room during the allotted meal times chosen by your group leader. Unclaimed meals will be covered and placed in the refrigerator in the hall.
4. Guests are encouraged to bring all used dinnerware (plates, cups, glasses, and cutlery) to the dirty dish trolley provided. (please scrape leftover food into the trash).
5. A refrigerator, microwave, and coffee/tea station is available for rental group use in the main hall in the evenings..
6. A refrigerator is available for rental group use in each cabin. (please ensure to empty your items from the refrigerator prior to departure).
7. Check-out time from the cabins is 10:00am. If your group is still using the hall area, please ensure that the cabin rooms are vacant, and all personal items have been removed.
